Subject: NO Objection Certificate to Start Degree Programs in Various Faculties/Departments at the Begum Nusrat Bhutto Women University, Sukkur Sindh

Dear Madam,

I am directed to refer your letter No. VCS/BNB-WU-SKR/55 of 2019 dated October 22, 2019 on the subject cited above and to state that following shortfalls/deficiencies have been found during initial scrutiny of the feasibility report of the Begum Nusrat Bhutto Women University, Sukkur. The University is required to:-

- i. Provide administrative approval of the Provincial Government for approval of PC-I of the University along with copy of its authorization letter;
- ii. Acquire NOC of Sindh Higher Education Commission;
- iii. Deposit remaining amount of Rupees 280,000/- (Two Hundred Eighty Thousand) in favor of DG(Finance), HEC Islamabad in lieu of feasibility evaluation fee;
- iv. Establish/constitute statutory bodies of the University as per provision of its Act;
- v. Hire full time administrative staff for the University and share appointment/joining orders of the claimed administrative staff;
- vi. Share details of existing departments established under several faculties;
- vii. Hire full time faculty in each proposed department as per HEC criteria and appointment/joining orders be provided;
- viii. Subscribe fifteen (15) Impact factor research journals having an impact an impact factor of at-least 1.00. Purchase invoices be provided;
- ix. Purchase fifteen Hundred (1500) books in each proposed department and purchase invoices be provided;
- x. Purchase computers and other ICT tools in the light of HEC criteria and purchase invoices be provided;
- xi. Share progress on Gantt chart regarding construction of purpose built campus of University at Deh Nandho Kohistan, Taqo Rohri District Sukkur and subsequent shifting;
- xii. Subscribe fifty (50) Mbps internet facility for the University and subscription invoices be shared;
- xiii. Equip Labs/workshops with necessary equipment as per requirement;
- xiv. Devise scholarship policy for the students covering at-least 10% students of the total enrollment;
- xv. Refrain from granting affiliation till constitution of statutory bodies and strengthening of its faculties at purpose built campus;
- xvi. Ensure availability of general facilities for the prospective students;
- xvii. Establish Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) and full time staff shall be appointed as per HEC criteria. Necessary notifications to this effect be shared;
- xviii. Share detail of hostel facility for the prospective students;

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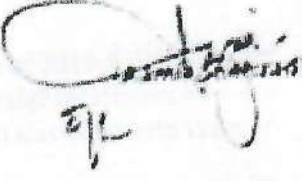
1. Share details of past and existing websites for the prospective students of the University.

2. The University is planning to start a computer center at various locations of the district. Further to that, an International Education Commission has been constituted which will visit the University in Government staff for selection of digital infrastructure, availability of academic and financial facilities. To start new and old students, the University is advised to release their addresses in any degree program.
