- The budget for the KCUE is classified into general funds, special funds, and Government funds. General funds are membership fee income from member universities, accounting for about 9.9% of the total budget.
- Special funds are aimed at realizing special purposes of the KCUE. They
 include University personnel training, support for admissions
 information-sharing, university admissions information fair, publication
 of "*Higher Education*", academic records verification service, and
 research services project costs, accounting for about 8.6% of the total
 budget.
- Government funds include the project costs supported by the government such as the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology, taking up about 81.5% of the total budget.
